Date – Tuesday; November 8, 2016

San Juan County will conduct the 2016 General Election using By-Mail ballots. Ballots will be mailed to voters by October 11, 2016. If you do not receive your ballot by October 17th, please contact the Clerk's Office or the Election Liaison, Ed Tapaha

For those wishing to vote in person the following polling locations will be open the day of the election, November 8, 2016. Services at the polling locations will include:

- In person voting
- Interpreters to assist voters further understand the ballot
- County agents to register new voters
