Moki Canyon and Castle Wash



Moki Canyon Trail
 Go south out of Blanding on Highway 191. A few miles south of Blanding, take Highway 95 to the west. Just past mile marker 84 on Highway 95 take Highway 276 to the southwest. Just past mile marker 63 on Highway 276 take County road 2221. You are now on the Moki Canyon trail. Refer to the map for trail details.

Castle Wash Trail
 Go south out of Blanding on Highway 191. A few miles south of Blanding, take Highway 95 to the west. Just past mile marker 84 on Highway 95 take Highway 276 to the southwest. Near mile marker 80 on 276 you will find a sign indicating ATV trail 96 to the south. This is the beginning of the Castle Wash trail. Refer to the map for further trail
