## San Juan County Trail System

### Falls/Missile Trail - Davis Canyon

**HOW TO GET THERE:**

Go north out of Monticello on Highway 191 for approximately 12 miles. Near mile post 86 you will come to the junction of 191 and 211. Highway 211, a paved road on the west side (left), goes to Canyonlands National Park. Follow this highway approximately 28 miles and you come to the junction of 211 and County road 122, Lockhart Basin on the north (right) side of the highway. Take 122 for about a mile and half and you will come to Hamburger Rock Campground on your right. Just beyond the campground you intersect Trail 25, on your left. A staging area will also be seen on the left.
