ROAD CONSTRUCTION IS ONGOING ON HIGHWAY 191 ON BLUE HILL

Road Construction is under way South of Moab

On March 5, 2018 Legrand Johnson Construction started work beginning at Milepost 112.5 working northward to Milepost 117.5. The primary goal of this roadwork is to provide passing and turnout lanes along the length of the project. Of the 3 areas where work is more concentrated. We are progressing from south to north, and will be working on all three sections this week.

Please watch for and pay attention to the orange signs, barrels & cones as they are intended to keep workers and the traveling public safe through the construction zone. There will be no weekend work at this time. Work could be extended beyond these days and hours if necessary, but if they are extended there will be advance notice.

Construction will be mainly on the shoulders of the road at the top (MP 112) and bottom (MP 114) of Blue Hill & going north. Lane closures and flagging operations with a pilot car will be occurring throughout the workdays this week, so expect delays. We will continue to provide updates as work progresses.
