Executive Meeting Held

A motion to come out of the executive session was made by Commissioner Grayeyes and 2nd by Commissioner Adams. Voting was unanimous.

Commissioner Grayeyes explained that the commission has considered whether to continue pursuing legal action or to stop pursuing legal action based on the decision of the 10th Circuit Court of Appeals regarding the redistricting case. With that information, Commissioner Adams 2nd the motion made by Commissioner Maryboy to not pursue any legal action regarding the Redistricting Case. There was some discussion clarifying the motion and 2nd made by Commissioners Maryboy and Adams. Voting on the motion was unanimous.
