# **GENERAL ELECTION**

## **SAN JUAN COUNTY UTAH**

## **NOVEMBER 6, 2018**

#### **BY MAIL BALLOT**

- Primary election ballots will be mailed to active voters by October 5, 2018
- If a voter wants to mail the ballot to County Clerk's Office, it must be postmarked by November 5, 2018
- Voters can cast their ballots at the satellite offices during the early voting period or cast their ballots at the polling places on Election Day

- Clerk's Office in Monticello 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

**NAVAJO LANGUAGE ASSISTANCE** 

- Navajo language assistance will be provided at each polling location
- San Juan County Utah is required under federal law to provide language assistance to voters that have a difficult time understanding the English language, Section 203 of the Voting Rights Act

#### **REGISTRATION DEADLINES**

- Last day to register to vote and receive a ballot via mail October 30th
- Voters may register at satellite locations and receive a ballot October 9<sup>th</sup> November 2<sup>nd</sup>
- Voters may register on the same day as the election and vote a provisional ballot November 6<sup>th</sup>
- Provisional ballot requires that the voter's residence be verified before the ballot is counted within 10 days of casting the ballot.
