- A. Crystal Holt requested approval to hire Lexi Latham as Part Time Building Maintenance at the PSB. Approval was granted with ratification to be made in the next Commission Meeting.
- B. Jerry McNeely discussed a road, in the Anticline area of Hatch Point, on which the BLM was requesting a change. With a short discussion, the commission requested additional information from the grazer in the area and a site visit by Jerry.
- C. Tim Chamberlain told the Commission about a Native American business development seminar on November 20th and the creation of a small business service center in the Arts & Events Building for area businesses that do not have computers or copy services.
- D. Tim gave a report on the Heritage Council meeting of last week.
- E. Nick Sandberg reviewed and discussed the area open houses meetings concerning the Public Land proposals. He feels a lot has been learned about what to do and how to present the information. The Open Houses have been well received with more to be held.
